Mark Reth opened the meeting and then Pastor Phil lead the devotional referencing a letter from Lifeway Ministries founder and also Proverbs 22:1.

Finance: Bruce gave the Financial Report that showed our actual income for July was \$21,791 and the actual expenses were \$16,715. Brick by Brick has cash on hand of \$46,696, which includes expenses of \$2,763 and \$200 contributions.

Trustees: Charlie reported that the work on the bathrooms is continuing.

Worship: May have to check into purchasing new candles. Effective September 17, services will be changed with the addition of a second service. Services will be 8:30 and 10:30 with Sunday School between the services.

Education: Sunday school will begin on September 17. There will be separate classes PreK2nd and 3-5. Also Adult Ed with 3-6 week studies. These will be Pathfinder, Foundry and Waymakers. There will be Confirmation and the curriculum is being devised by Kristen, Paul, Pastor Phil and Zach. The fun in the Park will be on September 10 with worship service beginning at 10:00 AM.

Mission: The Ice Cream Social was a success. The funds will be used for the account to keep the Wesley Hall floor looking good. There were several people involved in Neighbor Helping Neighbor after the recent wind storm and there has been one name submitted for Paint by Neighbor.

SP/PRC: Pastor Phil will be taking a 4 week Spritual Renewal with dates to be determined.

Reaching/Receiving: Lori replied by email that she is checking with local source for shirts.

Congregational Care: Sherry reported that cards were sent to members who have not been in attendance. The 80+ birthday celebration is scheduled for October 12.

Pastor Phil: Discussed the procedure for membership in Manchester Methodist Church. Dates for receiving members into the new MMC will be determined in the coming weeks.

Our next meeting will be on Tuesday, September 19, 2023 at 6:00 PM in Wesley Hall. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 PM followed by the Lord's Prayer.

New Logo Shirts are now available to be ordered. We have kept this local by getting Stay Wild Gifts in downtown Manchester to create/print our shirts.



A Word From Education


