# A note from Pastor Phil...

# And it came to pass, when the time was come that he should be received up, he steadfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem, - Luke 9:51 KJV



Jesus had, once again, just detailed the fate awaiting Him when He arrived in Jerusalem. Immediately after, Jesus "steadfastly set his face to go to Jerusalem."

We have been traveling together through the lens of Matthew on our Lenten journey of preparation to experience the triumphal entry into Jerusalem, the final teachings, the celebration of foot washing and the Last Supper, the arrest, suffering and death, and the celebration of resurrection.

Once again this year we will experience the triumphal entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, April 13<sup>th</sup> at both the 8:30 and 10:30 A.M. worship services.

This year on Holy Wednesday, April 16<sup>th</sup>, we shall add a new very special service at 7:00 P.M. focused on Jesus' final teachings in the temple leading up to the Passover Feast.

On April 17<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 P.M. we will experience Jesus washing the Disciples' feet, serving the Last Supper, praying in the Garden of Gethsemane, Judas' betrayal, and finally, Jesus' arrest.

Friday, April 18<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 P.M. will be a powerful experience of Jesus' shame, suffering, and death for the sake of grace for all of humanity.

Sunday, April 20<sup>th</sup> at both 8:30 and 10:30 A.M. we will celebrate that the tomb is empty - He is Risen! Come and share in our overwhelming joy at the empty tomb, and the awe of the significance of this miracle! The cross promises grace for sin so we can stand at peace with God in judgment. Jesus' resurrection promises eternal life in praise and presence with our Redeemer and Savior.

Let us finish this journey to the cross together...and along our way, gather all those we find who are known as the least and the lost.

# Manchester Methodist Church Single Board Minutes for March 18, 2025

**Present:** Lori Snyder, Shirley Davis, Wayne Birkenholz, Bruce Nodurft, Charlie Dighton, Paul Lyman, Kathy Dolan, Jean Gross, Pastor Phil, Mark Reth, Bill Scanlan.

**Pastor Phil opened the meeting with prayer.** He gave a recent report on his new granddaughter's eye surgery and said everyone is doing well and heading home soon. Prayers were lifted up for those facing challenges.

**Finance:** Actual income as of the end of February was \$33,440 and actual expenses were \$38,082 giving us a deficit as of -\$4,642 for this year. Bruce shared a report on our "Brick by Brick" campaign. 65% of the monies pledged from 73 commitments for church remodeling has been paid for a total amount of \$148,500. Of this money approximately \$20,700 remains after some projects were completed. We are still receiving a monthly donation from an individual for this project. The office remodels amounted to roughly \$33,750. Security cameras need to be installed yet.

**Trustees:** Papers are being drawn up for the team that will be managing Rahab House. The church will still own the property. The crying room will soon be ready for use. The old desk will be removed and a changing table will be available as well as a couple of rockers. Curtains will be purchased for the windows. The room will be completed for minimal or no cost. "**No Animals**" signs have been posted at the church entrances. Only official service dogs are allowed on Church property. Someone will be fixing the elevator phone so that calls can be made in case of emergency. The wall sanctuary lights over the choir will be replaced with LED lighting. Bids are being taken for the south entrance ramp. This will entail an aluminum ramp, concrete work, replacement of the exterior door, and removal of the interior door. Two contractors are being contacted for bids. The toilet in the nursery is being fixed.

**Christian Ed.:** Paul said that no one is stepping up to chair VBS so we will probably look at other options such as the community Bible School at the fairgrounds. We should have 3 or 4 confirmation students next year.

**Missions:** A check for \$1000 is being sent to Dirt Roads Network to support Zach Kingery's church planting efforts. Several donations have been made for the continuance of the KMCH radio broadcasts on Sunday night. "Paint by Neighbor" will continue to watch for candidates to consider including some from our congregation who might need spring yard/landscaping cleanup in April. They will remain open to accommodating such requests. Julie Porter has indicated she will again be the lead for the 2025 Ice Cream Social which is scheduled for Wednesday, July 30.

**Congregational Care:** Sherry reported that they served 20 from our congregation at the Valentine's Dinner. With the team, Pastor Phil, Lynne, Beth, and the speaker, we served approximately 33. On Saturday, March 22 we will be meeting at the Delhi Methodist Church for a Congregational Care District Conference. Along with other churches we will be giving a presentation on what our team does for Congregational Care, after which there will be table talks and sharing. Six members of our team of 9 are planning to attend.

**Reaching and Receiving:** Lori mentioned the church directory is at the printers and it is hoped we will have our copies by Easter.

**Our next meeting** will be April 15 at 6:00 p.m. Meeting adjourned at 7:20 p.m.

Over the course of 2024 and 2025, XL Specialized Trailers has recruited more than 40 families to relocate here for manufacturing jobs. These families are from Puerto Rico, a US territory, so they are US citizens. Most speak Spanish and are learning English as part of their jobs. They are projecting to hire another 30 this year.

It's exciting for our community to have so many new people moving here, and we want to welcome them to our town. Conversational English Gatherings offer a casual way for us to help them practice speaking English and build connections. We meet every other Sunday night at 6:00pm at the Manchester Methodist Church. Our next meeting is Sunday, April 6<sup>th</sup>.

You don't need to speak Spanish to participate, as we are assisting them in practicing their English speaking skills. All that is required is for individuals to attend and be friendly and welcoming.
